

Low Maintenance Turf Mix

A quick establishing, dense, low growing turf that requires less mowing. This mix is very fine textured, can be used in open sun and yet has good shade and drought tolerance. It tolerates poor soil conditions and low fertility. Not recommended for high traffic areas or athletic fields.

- 20% Hard Fescue
- 20% Chewings Fescue
- 20% Creeping Red Fescue
- 15% Kentucky Bluegrass,
- 15% Perennial Ryegrass
- 10% Kentucky Bluegrass, Parkland

PLANTING RATE 3-5 LBS. PER 1000 SQ. FT.

Native Turf Mix

This mixture represents our native shortgrass prairie. These native grasses are low maintenance due to low water requirements, low amounts of supplemental fertilization, and require infrequent mowing. Sharp's Improved Primed Buffalograss is selected for the variety's hybrid vigor and its wide geographical adaptation. Blue Grama (Colorado State grass), adds a slightly deeper cast to the very light green color of the buffalograss. They share many other qualities. Blue Grama is more adapted to sandy soil than pure buffalograss. NATIVE TURF turns straw-colored after the first frost in the fall and greens up with warmer weather in the late spring. Not recommended for elevations over 6000 feet. This mix displays excellent cold, heat and drought tolerance. It is not salt or shade tolerant. Heavy or constant traffic is not recommended.

- 66 2/3% Buffalograss, Sharp's
- 33 1/3% Blue Grama, Lovington

Supreme Lawn Mix

A mix of selected fine-textured lawn grass species that form a dense, uniform sod with outstanding deep color, excellent wearability, heat and drought tolerance, winterhardiness, and excellent disease resistance. SUPREME lawn mix incorporates the features of our ALLBLUE blend, then adds Creeping Red Fescue which tolerates poor soils and shade conditions and FOUR-PLAY Perennial Ryegrass blend to enhance quick establishment.

- 70% Kentucky Blue, Allblue
- 20% Perennial Rye, Four-Play
- 10% Creeping Red Fescue

Transition Turf Mix

In areas where the neighboring turf may be:

- more refined in culture and maintenance
- the possibility exists for area to be upgraded in the future

Transition Turf has been developed to provide for limited care initially but can adapt to additional care (perhaps even irrigation) in the future. Transition Turf seed mixture is based upon cultural conditions rather than environmental concerns. It should be used where soils have had soil preparation to insure best establishment.

Transition Turf is primarily composed of cool-season, sod-forming, naturalized species that do well on coarse infertile soils in the mountains and foothills. It is adapted to a broad range of soil textures, pH's, and exposures. Color is gray-green to blue-green with ¼ to ½ inch blade width. Transition Turf seed mix has good tolerance to traffic, tolerates both sun and shade, and somewhat tolerates compacted soil (such as you find around post-construction sites where heavy equipment has been in use). It tends to be more disease and insect resistant than Kentucky bluegrass.

Transition Turf should be mown no less than 3 inches to emulate a formal lawn look and maintain turf density. After establishment, expect a seasonal use of 18-20 inches per year (water ½ inch every week during hot, dry spells). Can be left unmowed (2-4 feet height) and used in "natural" style grassland plantings for areas where irrigation is impossible.

- 50% Smooth Brome, Lincoln
- 20% Perennial Ryegrass, Linn
- 20% Tall Fescue
- 10% Canada Bluegrass

4-Play Perennial Rye Blend

An outstanding blend of perennial ryegrasses that provides quick germination, turf durability, and rich color. 4-Play is high in endophyte for natural insect resistance and improved stress tolerance. On golf courses, it withstands low mowing for fairways, and cuts cleanly with no shredding.

Based upon the popular Emerald III Turf-type tall Fescue blend, we added Kentucky Bluegrass and FOUR-PLAY Turf-type Perennial Ryegrass blend for enhanced color, texture, density and early establishment.

- 80% Emerald III Tall Fescue
- 10% Four-Play Perennial Ryegrass
- 10% Parkland Kentucky Bluegrass

A mixture of grasses for the cost conscious homeowner. This blend will provide the homeowner a durable, moderately textured turf with quick emergence.

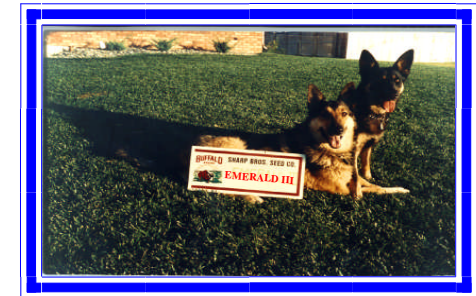
- 80% Kentucky Bluegrass

Tall Fescue, Emerald III Blend

A blend of elite varieties of Turf-type Tall Fescue. EMERALD III has a fine texture, rich dark green color and dense, uniform turf, with bluegrass-like qualities. EMERALD III is tough and durable. It's cold tolerant and can endure low mowing heights. Once established, it needs less feeding and thrives in hot weather and drought with limited watering. It bounces back from traffic and heavy use. An excellent choice for playgrounds, parks, athletic fields, industrial/business parks, golf course roughs, and home lawns. It will perform well in the shade and has a wide range of adaptability and pH tolerances.

Low Grow High Altitude Mix

A blend of low maintenance grasses establishes well in cooler areas above 7000 ft. elevation. The low growth habit lends itself to infrequent mowing.

- 30% Crested Wheat, Ephraim
- 25% Perennial Rye
- 20% Sheep Fescue
- 15% Canada Blue, Talon
- 10% Chewings Fescue
